

**VILLAGE OF DUBBERLY  
PROCEEDINGS OF COUNCIL  
DEC. 09, 2019**

The Village of Dubberly met for its regular monthly meeting on Monday, Dec. 09, 2019 at 6:30 p.m.

Notice of meeting was posted on the marquee sign at 12:00 Noon on Friday, Dec.06, 2019.

Those present were Curtis Hirth, Johnny Brown, Douglas Culpepper, Lynn Cooley, Charles Mims and Jeff Lair.

The meeting was opened in prayer by Doug Culpepper and followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from the regular meeting of Nov. 11, 2019 were read and a motion was made by Johnny Brown and seconded by Douglas Culpepper to accept the minutes as read. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Johnny Brown and seconded by Douglas Culpepper to accept financial reports. The motion carried.

Chief Mims reported that in October he responded to 12 calls, issued 15 citations and collected \$136.00 in fines. In November he responded to 10 calls, issued 12 citations and collected \$836.00 in fines.

Curtis is in favor of an increase of salary for the water operator and the clerk. Jeff would like an increase of \$147.50 per month to bring his salary to \$2000.00 per month. Dianne would like to receive an increase of at least \$100.00 per month. Johnny Brown moved to raise Jeff's salary to \$2000.00 per month and re-evaluate in 5 years. Lynn Cooley seconded, and the motion carried. Lynn Cooley moved to increase Dianne's salary to \$1600.00 per month and re-evaluate in 3 years. Johnny seconded, and the motion carried.

The council has reviewed the proposed budgets for the year of 2020 that they received last month. Johnny Brown made a motion to accept the proposed budget for the water system and Douglas Culpepper seconded. The motion carried. Johnny Brown made the motion to accept the proposed budget for the village with Lynn Cooley seconding. The motion carried.

Johnny requested that we have a breakdown of water produced and water sold to help with rate discussion. Jeff will begin tracking how much water is produced in a month and Dianne will provide a billing breakdown.

There being no further business, motion made by Johnny Brown and seconded by Douglas Culpepper to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
