

**VILLAGE OF DUBBERLY
PROCEEDINGS OF COUNCIL
MARCH 9, 2020**

The Village of Dubberly met for its regular monthly meeting on Monday, March 9, 2020 at 6:30 p.m.

Notice of meeting was posted on the marquee sign at 12:00 Noon on Friday, March 6, 2020.

Those present were Curtis Hirth, Johnny Brown, Douglas Culpepper, Lynn Cooley, Jeff Lair and Charles Mims.

The meeting was opened in prayer by Johnny Brown and followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from the regular meeting of Feb 10, 2020 were read and a motion was made by Douglas Culpepper and seconded Johnny Brown to accept the minutes as read. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Johnny Brown and seconded by Lynn Cooley to accept financial reports. The motion carried.

Chief Mims reported that in February he responded to 10 calls, issued 5 citations and did not collect any fines.

Douglas Culpepper to contact the people that expressed an interest in paying their water bills by credit or debit cards and will report back next month. We had approximately 24 sign up in the office.

Jeff got bids to replace the deteriorating pipes at the Catalpa well. Coburns submitted a bid of \$4629.11, Ferguson Waterworks submitted one for \$4431.78. Johnny made a motion to go with Ferguson Waterworks, Douglas seconded, and the motion carried.

Douglas made a recommendation to raise the minimum water rate for residential 2000 gallons to \$20.00 and to raise usage of the next 8000 gallons to \$1.50 per thousand-gallon, usage of 10,000 gallons and over to \$2.00 per thousand gallons. He suggested that the double hooked meters minimum be changed to 4000 gallons for \$36.00 and to raise the usage of the next 16,000 gallons to \$1.50 per thousand gallons, usage of next 20,000 gallons to \$1.75 per thousand gallons. For business meters he suggested a minimum of \$35.00 for the first 10,000 gallons and anything over that be \$2.00 per thousand. He requested that the council think it over and revisit it next month.

There being no further business, motion made by Douglas Culpepper and seconded by Johnny Brown to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:03 p.m.
