The Village of Dubberly met for its regular monthly meeting on Monday, Nov. 11, 2019 at 6:30 p.m.

Those present were Curtis Hirth, Johnny Brown, Douglas Culpepper, Lynn Cooley and Jeff Lair. Charles Mims was absent.

The meeting was opened in prayer by Johnny Brown and followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Curtis asked Johnny for an update on the 20 HP motor for the Catalpa well. Johnny reported that he has spoken with Trent and will be ordering the 20 HP motors with 8-inch impellers tomorrow.

Dianne reported on the LMCA training that she attended in Baton Rouge and informed the council that along with adopting the sexual harassment policy last month everyone is required to take a 1 hour online sexual harassment course each year.

The council was presented with the proposed budget amendments for the village general fund and the water system for the 2019 fiscal year.
