PROCEEDINGS OF COUNCIL
NOVEMBER 9, 2020**

The Village of Dubberly met for its regular monthly meeting on Monday, Nov. 9, 2020 at 6:30 p.m.

Notice of meeting was posted on the marquee sign at 12:00 Noon on Friday, Nov. 6, 2020.

Those present were Curtis Hirth, Johnny Brown, Douglas Culpepper, Charles Mims, Jeff Lair, Brian Dison and Lynn Cooley.

The meeting was opened in prayer by Douglas Culpepper and followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chief Mims reported that in September he responded to 5 calls, in October he responded to 7 calls, he did not issue any citations or collect any fines for either month. Chief reported that there has not been any progress made on the town hall burglary. He also asked what the procedure would be for the transfer of police department property to Brian Dison. After discussion it was decided that the transfer will take place at the town hall.

Curtis reported that there will be another bid opening in December. The engineers have updated the bid package to reflect requested changes. They are trying to get as many companies to bid as possible.

Council questioned how we are allowed to invest the village money and will table the discussion until more information can be obtained.

Johnny Brown made a motion to add discussion of burglary to the agenda, Lynn Cooley seconded, and the motion carried. Curtis reported that the door had been repaired except for the tint being installed. He would like to consider antitheft bars, and getting working cameras. Cameras run \$250.00 and up. Douglas and Brian will check on cameras.

There being no further business, motion made by Douglas Culpepper and seconded by Johnny Brown to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 7.01 p.m.
