VILLAGE OF DUBBERLY PROCEEDINGS OF COUNCIL SEPTEMBER 14, 2020

The Village of Dubberly met for its regular monthly meeting on Monday, September 14, 2020 at 6:30 p.m.

Notice of meeting was posted on the marquee sign at 12:00 Noon on Friday, September 11, 2020.

Those present were Curtis Hirth, Charles Mims, Johnny Brown and Douglas Culpepper. Lynn Cooley was absent.

Meeting was opened in prayer by Johnny Brown and followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from the meeting of August 10, 2020 were read and a motion was made by Johnny Brown and seconded by Douglas Culpepper to accept the minutes as read. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Johnny Brown and seconded by Douglas Culpepper to accept financial reports. The motion carried.

Chief Mims reported that in June he responded to 7 calls, did not issue any citations, and did not collect any fines.

Curtis reported that Complete Well Service withdrew their bid for the Patterson well due to age and health concerns. KWS Water Well Drilling was a sub-contractor and provided the bid guarantee check. Douglas Culpepper made a motion to return the guarantee check to KWS Water Well Drilling with Johnny Brown providing the second. Douglas made a motion to accept the bid withdrawal and Johnny Brown seconded. Both motions carried.

Curtis informed the counsel that the LAMP account interest rate has dropped significantly and that we could get a better rate with a savings account at the bank. Douglas Culpepper will speak with a financial advisor and report back at the next meeting.

Johnny Brown introduced the Claiborne Electric Franchise Fee Ordinance. Public hearing will be held next month to discuss the ordinance.
