The Village of Dubberly met for its regular monthly meeting on Monday, February 8, 2021 at 6:30 p.m.

Notice of meeting was posted on the marquee sign at 12:00 Noon on Friday, February 5, 2021.

Those present were Curtis Hirth, Johnny Brown, Douglas Culpepper, Jeff Lair and Brent Cooley. Brian Dison was absent.

The meeting was opened in prayer by Johnny Brown and followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from the meeting of Jan. 11, 2020 were read and a motion was made by Douglas Culpepper and seconded by Johnny Brown to accept the minutes as read. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Johnny Brown and seconded by Douglas Culpepper to accept financial reports. The motion carried.

No police report was given as Chief Dison was out for training purposes.

Curtis reported that the pre-construction meeting with McManus Engineering and Hydroline will take place on February 9, 2021.

Douglas recommends getting an Arlo Security system with 2 cameras. Dianne to check on cost.

Curtis reported that we received 3 bids for security bars, Hercules AG \$300.00, Perryman Welding 1) stainless steel mesh, \$2085.00, 2) Metal, \$1020.00. Johnny made a motion to hold off on the security bars for now. Douglas seconded and the motion carried.

Johnny made a motion for a resolution for the Webster Parish Police Jury to preform necessary side cutting and ditch cleaning for the 2021 calendar year. Brent Cooley seconded, and the motion carried.

Johnny also made a motion for the Webster Parish Police Jury to continue with the overlaying of Brushwood Drive from where they left off last year and continuing west as far as funds will allow. Douglas seconded and the motion carried.

Curtis informed the council that due to the number of lightning claims we have had this year our insurance company is requiring us to have lightning rods installed on all of the wells. We have received 2 bids. J. Corrigan's bid is \$19,860.00 and Donohue Lightning Rods bid is \$3700.00. Johnny made the motion to go with Donohue Lightning Rods, Brent Cooley seconded, and the motion carried.
