VILLAGE OF DUBBERLY PROCEEDINGS OF COUNCIL MARCH 8, 2021

The Village of Dubberly met for its regular monthly meeting on Monday, March 8, 2021 at 6:30 p.m.

Notice of meeting was posted on the marquee sign at 12:00 Noon on Friday, March 5, 2021.

Those present were Curtis Hirth, Johnny Brown, Douglas Culpepper, Jeff Lair, Brian Dison and Brent Cooley.

The meeting was opened in prayer by Brian Dison and followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from the meeting of Feb. 8, 2021 were read and a motion was made by Brent Cooley and seconded by Johnny Brown to accept the minutes as read. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Douglas Culpepper and seconded by Johnny Brown to accept financial reports. The motion carried.

Brian Dison reported that he must be POST certified to receive the \$500.00 a month supplement from the state. This is a new requirement that became effective as of Jan. 1, 2021. To become certified, he must attend 15 weeks of full-time training. He cannot take that much time off from his job. When the COVID restrictions are lifted he will be able to go to Monroe for the training in a night course format. Brian would like the Police Department to subsidize the supplement until he can become certified. Council will table until next month.

Curtis reported that Hydroline started construction of the new well on March 7, 2021 and were down to 500 feet on the 8th of March. The original Patterson well must be closed or repaired to provide non-potable water. To close the well will cost more than \$30,000.00. To fit with a smaller pump for non-potable use will be approximately \$13,000.00. Douglas made the motion to repair the well with Johnny seconding, the motion carried.

Curtis reported that the Arlo security system has been installed and is operational.

Curtis informed the council that the lightning protection installation is complete.

Johnny made a motion to add to two items to the agenda. Douglas seconded.

Curtis read the resolution regarding the Louisiana Attestation Questionnaire that is required for the audit. Brian Cooley made a motion to adopt the resolution, Johnny Brown seconded, and the motion carried.

Curtis moved to appoint Brian Dison as the Sargent at Arms. Johnny Brown made the motion and Brent Cooley seconded, and the motion carried.

There being no further business, motion made by Johnny and seconded by Douglas Culpepper to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 7:14 p.m.
