

**VILLAGE OF DUBBERLY
PROCEEDINGS OF COUNCIL
MAY 10, 2021**

The Village of Dubberly met for its regular monthly meeting on Monday, May 10, 2021 at 6:30 p.m.

Notice of meeting was posted on the marquee sign at 12:00 Noon on Friday, May 7, 2021.

Those present were Curtis Hirth, Douglas Culpepper, Brian Dison, Johnny Brown and Brent Cooley. Also attending was Attorney Jimbo Yocum.

The meeting was opened in prayer by Johnny Brown and followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from the meeting of April 12, 2021, were read and a motion was made by Brent Cooley and seconded by Johnny Brown to accept the minutes as read. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Brent Cooley and seconded by Douglas Culpepper to accept financial reports. The motion carried.

Brian Dison reported that he answered 4 calls, issued 4 citations, and received \$628.50 in fines. He stated that there have been approximately 16 warrants issued this week for outstanding tickets.

Patterson well update – the first water test that was done in April came back with an Iron level of 3.19 mg/l and the EPA limit is .30 mg/l. The Manganese level was .0323 mg/l with the EPA limit of .005 mg/l. They performed a retest last week and the results are back with little or no detectable Iron or Manganese in the water. The results will have to go to the Department of Health and Hospitals for review. Mr. McManus anticipates Hydrolite to be able to resume work next week with expected completion around the middle of June.

Mayors Court update – Mr. Jimbo Yocum presented what we would need to do to begin a mayor's court and the approximate cost as follows, Mr. Yocum presiding over the court - \$500.00 per month. Necessary recording equipment - \$250.00. Quick PD software for recording tickets and processing fines \$99.00 per month. Douglas made a motion to table the discussion to a later date with Johnny seconding and the motion carrying.

Curtis informed the council of the anticipated American Rescue Plan funds and the need for a new checking account to track these funds. Johnny made the motion to open the account and Douglas seconded. The motion carried.

Johnny made a motion to add an item to the agenda, motion carried. The WPPJ is having an auction if we are interested in purchasing any of their equipment.

Curtis reported that Jeff has completed the Pierce Lane work.

There being no further business, motion made by Johnny Brown and seconded by Douglas Culpepper to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
