ORDINANCE NO. 2020-0721

To amend Ordinance 2001-B, to change residential minimum in Paragraph A under "Rates". To amend Ordinance 2001-A, to change residential minimum in Article B, Paragraph A under "Rates". To amend Ordinance 1992-A, Paragraph "B" under "Rates"

The water rates are as follows, and they are hereby established by the Village of Dubberly, but may be modified hereafter, without the need of an amended ordinance, by resolution of the Board of Alderman, the rates to be established as follows:

"A" Residential: The minimum monthly residential rate shall be \$21.00 for the first 2,000 gallons used, \$2.80 per thousand gallons used or part thereof for the next 8,000 gallons, \$3.30 per thousand used or part thereof for all over 10,000 gallons.

Double hooked residences (2 households on the same property connected to one meter): The minimum monthly residential rate shall be \$42.00 for the first 4,000 gallons used, \$2.80 per thousand gallons used or part thereof for the next 16,000 gallons, \$3.30 per thousand used or parts thereof for all over 20,000 gallons.

"B" Commercial: The minimum monthly commercial rates shall be \$35.00 per month for the first 10,000 gallons used, plus an additional \$3.30 per thousand or part thereof for all over 10,000 gallons.

This ordinance shall become effective for the July 2020 usage that will be billed by August 1, 2020.

All ordinance or parts of ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

If any provision or item of this ordinance or the application thereof is held invalid such invalidity shall not affect any other provisions, item, or applications of this ordinance or of the original ordinance, which could be given effect without the invalid provisions, items or applications and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable.
